The Swiss Rifle Clubs of Thames-Valley, Toronto, Ottawa and Montreal have joined together for a sixth biennial Kantonalschützenfest/Tir cantonal. This event will be held the weekend of June 9, 2007, in Ottawa, Ontario. This is a major change but was necessary as Kingston CFB was no longer able to guarantee to a necessary degree the range and bunking facilities in which to setup the event. The Ottawa CFB does provide this and has adequate backups. This letter is to layout the rules and explain what the fees cover. The purpose of this event remains the same as all previous Kantonalschützenfest/Tir cantonal: to meet and socialize with the other clubs and enjoy some competitive shooting. The range will be open at 09h00 on Saturday, for setup.

SAFETY:

A strict adherence to safety must be maintained at all times. Every participant is responsible for his/her conduct with the handling of firearms and being around firearms. As required by Federal law, all individuals who bring firearms to this event must have all proper paper work for possessing and transporting firearms. The organizers, individual clubs and the Canadian Military are not responsible for this and by attending you agree that all responsibility is with the firearm user. Any and all alcoholic beverage consumption will not be tolerated and is expressly forbidden on the range by order of the Base Commander. All firearms will require breech flags.

ANYONE WHO DISREGARDS THE SAFETY OF THE PARTICIPANTS OR PARTICIPATES IN ANY ACTIVITY WHICH COULD BE CONSIDERED TO EVEN COMPROMISE THE SAFETY OF THE EVENT WILL BE TOLD TO LEAVE.

COSTS:

The cost for this year's event is \$57. This is a decrease from last event and is even a decrease from the cancelled event in 2006. What it covers are outlined here:

- Usage of the range and any administration cost
- Lunch on the range
- Dinner (excluding alcoholic drinks)

Accommodations and Sunday breakfast are now no longer included. The arranging of accommodations, back in Kingston, was an extremely time consuming and nerve racking issue. I am glad to no longer have to deal with this. The Ottawa club members have offered space at their homes. Please indicate on the application for and we will try to the best of our abilities to find bunking, but failing this there are many motel and hotels in the area to suit all manner of tastes.

If the event is canceled the paid fees, less any non-refundable deposits, will be refunded.

There are two competitive programs: \$22 for the Hauptdoppel, \$15 for the Nachdoppel. The Lotto program has been discontinued. Ammunition is included for the programs and practice ammunition can be purchased on the range.

EVENT RULES:

Anyone who wishes to participate in the shooting programs of this Kantonalschützenfest/Tir cantonal, must show targets for his/her fellow shooters. Shooting and target showing shifts will be ~1.5 hours long but will be determined at the range.

Scorekeeper and shooter are not allowed to be from the same club. Make sure that the colours on the name badges are not identical.

The following rifles can be used: Swiss Army Ordonnanzwaffen (from 1893 onwards),
No 1st generation Langgewehr (equipped with a twelve round magazine) is allowed.

No rifle mounted optical enhancing devices are allowed (i.e. scopes). Only the issued sight or diopter are allowed. The rifles may be rested.

This competition will be held on the Saturday, June 9, beginning at 9AM, weather permitting. Sunday, June 10 will be the backup.

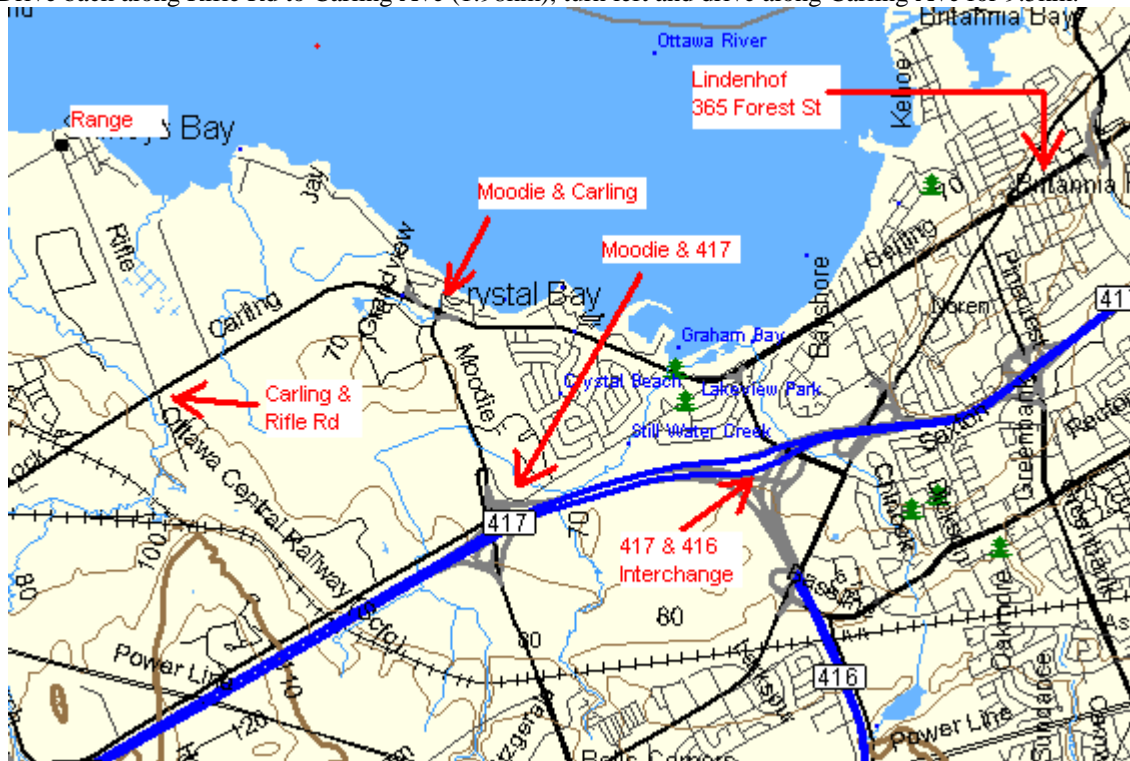
Dinner will be held at the Lindenhof restaurant. Where you can chose between begin with a salad and then chose between five main courses and two desserts. Arrangements for a cash bar have been made and there is ample free parking at the restaurant. An awards ceremony will follow the evening dinner.

How to get to the range:

From Mitchell, Toronto, Ottawa and Montreal first reach the 416 & 417 interchange (N45 20.549, W75 48.909), then head west to the 417 & Moodie Dr exit. Head north on Moodie Dr and at Carling Ave (1.7km) turn west (left). Drive along Carling Ave until Rifle Rd (2.35km). Turn right (north) and drive along Rifle Rd for 1.98km.

How to get to the Lindenhof from the range:

Drive back along Rifle Rd to Carling Ave (1.98km), turn left and drive along Carling Ave for 9.5km.
